

## Entry Instructions

The Foxcatcher 2012 is tentatively hosting two additional competitions, the FEI\* 50 and the AHA 50 2012 Region 15 Championship. Pending final sanction approvals, we welcome all competitors who plan to compete. Because there are special requirements for each group we are asking that you follow the guidelines listed below to help us keep the ride running smoothly.

**FOXCATCHER ENTRY Form- ALL COMPETITORS RIDING ON THE 14<sup>TH</sup> MUST COMPLETE THE FOXCATCHER ENTRY AND SIGN THE RELEASE.** All fees are listed on the Foxcatcher entry form and payment info must be completed on that form

(Pending final approval from USEF/FEI)

**FEI\* Entry-** In addition to the Foxcatcher entry & release, competitors for the FEI ride must complete the FEI form and sign that release. Fees for the ride are included on the Foxcatcher entry form. Passports are not required. Riders must include copies of USEF & FEI cards. Please note that you must include the influenza vaccine record for your horse with your entry as per FEI requirements

### **EQUINE INFLUENZA VACCINATION, VET. REGS. ANNEX VI** (except events taking place in NZL & AUS)

From 1 January 2005 onwards, influenza vaccination for all Horses competing in FEI competitions requires a vaccination within six months + 21 days of the competition.

1. All Horses intending to participate in FEI competition must have at least received an initial primary course of two vaccinations, given between 21 and 92 days apart. Thereafter, a third dose (referred to as the first booster) must be given within 7 months after the date of administration of the second primary dose, with at least annual boosters given subsequently (i.e. within one year of the last dose).

2. If the Horse is scheduled to take part in an FEI competition, the last booster must have been given within 6 months + 21 days of arrival at the FEI Event. (The 21-day window has been provided to enable vaccination requirements to fit in with the competition schedule).

3. No vaccination shall be given within 7 days of the day of arrival at the FEI Event.

4. All Horses that were certified as correctly vaccinated under the previous FEI equine influenza vaccination rule prior to 1st January 2005, do not need to start a primary course again provided that they have complied with the previous rule of primary course and annual re-vaccinations and the new rule of a booster vaccination within 6months + 21 days of the day of arrival at the FEI Event.

**AHA Region 15 Championship Entry-** In addition to the Foxcatcher entry & release forms, competitors must complete the AHA entry and release forms. Entry requires a copy of both the rider and horse current AHA cards to be eligible for this competition. The fees for this ride are included on the Foxcatcher entry form.

## RELEASE AGREEMENT FOR ALL RIDERS

The undersigned, seeks voluntarily to participate in the Foxcatcher Endurance Ride. As a participant in the Foxcatcher Endurance Ride, I agree to abide by A.E.R.C. rules and ECTRA rules. The undersigned, in consideration of accepting this entry does hereby, for himself, his heirs, executors, and administrators, waive and release the Foxcatcher Endurance Ride, Fair Hill International, Inc. and all individual members thereof, the American Endurance Ride Conference, Eastern Competitive Trail Ride Association, the Fair Hill Department of Natural Resources, and all other persons regardless of their capacity in any way connected with the event described herein, their representatives, heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns from any and all right, claim or liability for damages or for any and all injuries that may be sustained by me including injuries to animals, or from any and all claims of any kind or nature that I might have.

Further, I do hereby acknowledge that said release will extend to any accidents, damages, or claims arising out of my entry caused by my own act or the acts of anyone or any animal within my control. I understand that the sport involves being in remote areas for extended periods of time, far from communications, transportation, and medical facilities, that these areas may have natural and manmade hazards, which ride management cannot anticipate, identify, modify or eliminate, that horses can be excitable, difficult to control and unpredictable and that accidents can happen to anyone at any time.

I accept responsibility for myself and the animal I ride. I hold Ride Management, all personnel and the property owners including the Fair Hill Department of Natural Resources, blameless and free from all liability for injury or loss that might occur due to my participation in the ride. I understand that this release constitutes a limitation on my legal rights. Any action instituted against Fair Hill International, Inc must be filed in the State of Maryland. I certify that my animal is not under the influence of any drugs during the event. I further agree to allow any drug testing on the animal I ride, as deemed necessary by the ride management. This release is valid for my animals, personal belongings, family or guests in my company. This release applies for the entire ride, arrival, during and until departure. I have read, understand and accept this release.

*I understand that if the horse I am riding is pulled for metabolic reasons and requires treatment on site or additional recheck by ride vet, this horse may not leave base camp until released by an authorized ride vet.*

*I have read and agree to abide by all conditions set forth in this release and entry form.*
